The Beauty of Mandalay



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Maha Muni Pagoda

Built to enshrine the Maha Muni image, it is 17 feet (4 metres) high and is covered with too much gold. It is a must-visit site for any visitors coming to Mandalay.



Mandalay Palace was destroyed during World War Two and a replica of Mandalay Royal Palace was built in 1995 with exact copies of the original pavilions and throne. It is a must-visit place while in Mandalay.



Mandalay Hill

Mandalay Hill gave the city its name. Although the city was officially named 'Nikamshan' or 'Mount of Gems', people always called it after the name of the hill. The hilltop offers unforgettable sunset view of the city, the palace walls and the Ayeerwady River.



Kathodaw Pagoda

Officially known as the Mahalekha Museum Kathodaw Pagoda, it is called "the largest book in the world" where the 5th Buddhist Synod was held in 1859 by King Mindon, the founder of Mandalay.



Zego Market

Having existed as a business hub for nearly 90 years, the present market was rebuilt in 1996 where you can buy anything at one roof.



Shwe Kyaung Monastery

Out of the hundreds of monasteries in and around Mandalay, "Shwe Kyaung" or "Shwe Nandan", the Golden Palace Monastery is the most impressive one in distinctive Myanmar style.



Marble Carving

Mandalay is the hub where all sorts of marble statues are carved and distributed all over the country as well as abroad. While visiting Mahamuni Pagoda, do pay a visit to Kyaukseitin the main street of marble carving.



Pyin Oo Lwin

Also known as MayMye, it is a tranquil oasis of cool weather and amazing wild flowers with pretty waterfalls and strawberry fields.
